AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND PERMITTING ALDERMEN OR MEMBERS OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TURRELL TO CONTRACT WITH OR HAVE AN INTEREST IN A CONTRACT WITH THE MUNICIPALITY FOR THE FURNISHING OF SUPPLIES, EQUIPMENT OR SERVICES TO BE PERFORMED FOR THE MUNICIPALITY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TURRELL, ARKANSAS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The Mayor and Aldermen may conduct business with the City as authorized by Act 485 of 1961, under the following conditions:

- A. The purchase is under \$2,000.00 in value and comparable merchandise or equipment at comparable prices is not otherwise available within the City.
- B. The cost of the service is under \$2,000.00 in value and comparable services at comparable prices are not otherwise available within the City.
- SECTION 2. On all purchases of supplies, equipment or services of more than \$2,000.00 advertisement for bids must be taken pursuant to Ark. Stat. 19-4425, unless the City Council shall by Ordinance waive competitive bidding in exceptional situations where such procedure is deemed not feasible or practical.
- SECTION 3. Whereas in many instances the Mayor or Aldermen are the only merchants in the City who sell certain items and also the Mayor or Aldermen are the only persons who can supply certain services and it will work a great hardship on the City, if they must purchase supplies, equipment and services outside the City. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance being necessary for the immediate protection of the

public peace, health and safety, shall take effect immediately on its passage and approval.

SECTION 4. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby specifically repealed.
